

LARUE COUNTY GRANT FOR NONPROFITS – FY24

The LaRue County Fiscal Court established the LARUE COUNTY American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) GRANT PROGRAM from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) that was signed into law in March 2021. Many Nonprofits were unable to apply. The purpose of the LARUE COUNTY Grant for Nonprofits – FY24 is to assist local nonprofits in providing essential and beneficial services to the County and its communities for economic benefit of the LaRue County economy and strengthening them to sustain said services.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

1. Projects must be located in LaRue County.
2. The U.S. Treasury defines a nonprofit as 501(c) tax-exempt organizations.
3. The U.S. Treasury adopted the final rule implementing the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program under the American Rescue Plan. The LaRue County Fiscal Court seeks to assist local nonprofits that the Final Rule has identified as Impacted Nonprofits that have experienced
 - Decreased revenue
 - Financial insecurity
 - Increased costs (i.e., uncompensated services)
 - Capacity to weather financial hardship
 - Challenges covering payroll, rent or mortgage and other operating costs
 - Experienced a lull or loss of service to the community/county.
4. Ineligible uses that are prohibited
 - Contributions to rainy day funds and similar financial reserves
 - Payment of interest or principal on outstanding debt also to include fees or issuance costs associated with the issuance of new debt
5. Grants will range from \$500 to \$20,000.
6. Deadline to apply is September 8, 2023.
7. Awards to be made by October 1, 2023.
8. All funds, if awarded are to be disbursed via reimbursement.
9. Deadline for reimbursements will be May 31, 2024.
10. No reimbursement will be made for expenditures made prior to the date of the letter of grant award from Fiscal Court.

GRANT PROCESS

1. Applications can be picked up in person at the LaRue County Judge Executive's office.
